BYLAW #9 - 1992

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES AND SNOW FENCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Orkney #244, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. The council is hereby authorized to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting snow fences as a measure to prevent the blocking of roads by snow drifts during winter months.
- 2. The person or persons authorized by council to perform the work as herein provided shall have the right of entry on private property for such purposes only.
- 3. That any patrol operator being employed by the Rural Municipality of Orkney #244, at the direction of a member of the council, be authorized to enter onto private land for the purpose of ridging snow or erecting snow fences during winter months.
- 4. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the municipality engaged in carrying out the provisions of this bylaw, or who destroys, pulls down, alters or interferes with any works carried out or thing done under the authority of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties as prescribed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
