Bylaw No. 7/2011


A Bylaw Respecting Connection to the Yorkville Public Utility Sewer and Water Mains

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of this bylaw shall apply within the limits of and surrounding lands of the Pleasant Heights and Collacott Subdivisions within the boundary of the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244 as shown on the attached map identified as Schedule "A" appended hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
2. Parcels lying adjacent to existing Yorkville Public Utility Board Water and Sewer Lines shall be required to connect to the Utility Board Water and Sewer systems:
 - a) If the parcel has received an Order from the Public Health Officer to decommission an existing faulty private sewage system;
 - b) If an application is made to the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244 for construction of a new residential dwelling.
3. Bylaw No. 3/2001 is hereby repealed
