
BYLAW NO 13/2017

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR REGULATION OF SPEED OF CERTAIN VEHICLES ON CERTAIN ROADS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

This bylaw shall be referred to as the Road Restrictions Bylaw

- a) No person shall operate a motor vehicle of a weight of 10 tonnes or greater at a speed of greater than 60 (sixty) kilometers per hour on the municipal roads as per maps attached hereto as Appendix A.
2. Signs indicating the maximum speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed area.
3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
4. This bylaw comes into force and effect upon final passing thereof.








