




**A BYLAW TO AMENDING BYLAW 4-2010, AUTHORIZING THE
AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF YORKTON RESPECTING FIRE
PROTECTION SERVICES**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

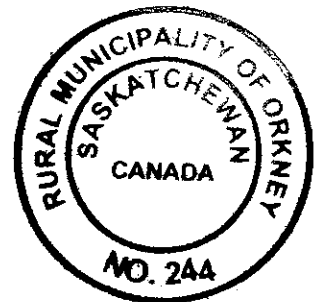
1. The Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244 is hereby authorized to enter into the addendum to the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, identified as "Exhibit A" with the City of Yorkton respecting fire suppression and rescue services.
2. The Reeve and the Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to sign and execute the attached addendum agreement identified as "Exhibit A"
3. Bylaw No. 4-2010 is hereby amended.



Addendum to Fire Protection Agreement of April 12, 2010 made in duplicate and dated this 19th day of December, 2017.

Between

CITY OF YORKTON
of Saskatchewan, a Municipal Corporation

Hereinafter referred to as "CITY"

-and-

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ORKNEY NO. 244
of Saskatchewan, a Municipal Corporation

Hereinafter referred to as "RURAL
MUNICIPALITY"

WHEREAS:

1. In this Addendum:
 - a) "Agreement" means the original Fire Protection Service agreement dated April 12, 2010 between the City and the Rural Municipality.
 - b) "Addendum" means an agreed upon addition attached hereto and forming part of the Agreement, signed off by the City and the Rural Municipality detailing the specific terms, clauses, sections and definitions to be changed in the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE:

2. This Addendum shall serve to modify the Agreement as follows:
 - a) That where "Budget" is referred to in the Agreement, it shall mean the cost of the Operations of the Fire Department in it's entirety, inclusive, but not limited to: annual fleet allocations to refurbish and maintain fire engine trucks and ladder trucks; and further shall not include capital debt payments, namely the Fire Hall debt.

b) Section 2. of the Agreement shall be modified to read:

- i) *The Rural Municipality will pay the City of Yorkton on an annual basis, an amount based upon the following formula:*

$$\frac{\text{Previous Year R.M. Taxable Assessment within five (5) miles of the City of Yorkton Fire Hall}}{\text{Previous Year Total Assessment within five (5) miles of the City of Yorkton Fire Hall}}$$

x Total Annual Budget for the Fire Hall = annual Rural Municipality payment to the City

- ii) Effective for the year 2018 and onward, if a discrepancy results when comparing the actual operating costs to the previous year's budget, as over or under, an adjustment as an addition or subtraction will be utilized in the formula as mentioned in section 2(b)(i) of the Addendum to achieve future budget numbers.

Example for 2018:

Taxable Assessment \$190,409,695/\$1,991,666,515 = 9.56%

(2018 Budget \$3,000,000) – (Adjustment \$60,000 [2017 actual is less than budget]) = \$2,940,000

\$2,940,000 X 9.56% = \$281,064 2018 Annual Rural Payment to the City

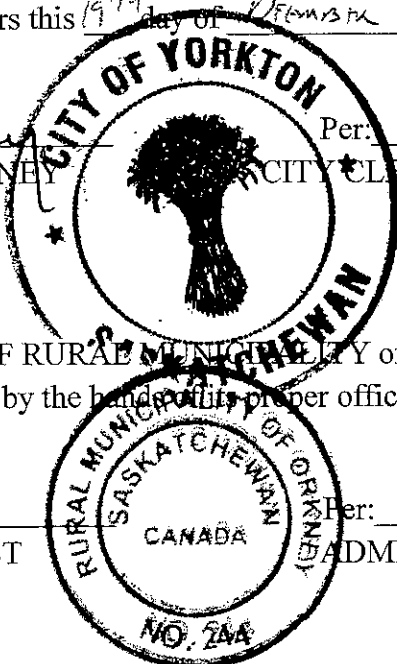
