RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ORKNEY NO. 244

BYLAW No. 6/2024

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

For the purposes of this bylaw:

- a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
- b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
- c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Orkney No. 244; and
- d) "person receiving the service" shall mean the registered owner of the land, building, vehicle or other equipment that the fire or situation occurred on.

2. Costs of Services

The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged to the Municipality and invoiced as custom work to the persons who receive the service in accordance with the rates contained within the following Bylaws, which may be revised from time to time:

A Bylaw to Enter Into an Agreement with the City of Melville for Fire Prevention, Protection and Emergency Services,

A Bylaw to Enter Into an Agreement with the City of Yorkton for Fire Prevention, Protection and Emergency Services,

A Bylaw to Enter Into an Agreement with the Town of Springside for Fire Prevention, Protection and Emergency Services,

A Bylaw to Enter Into an Agreement with the Village of Ebenezer for Fire Prevention, Protection and Emergency Services,

3. Invoicing

The Administrator or delegate shall invoice the persons that received the service within thirty days of receiving the amounts payable from the Municipalities contracted service provider(s), which will include a summary copy of the billing received by the municipality from the contracted service provider. All invoices shall be subject to any penalties established by the municipality and those costs become due and payable.

4. Amounts Added as Tax Arrears

The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or sixty days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.

 This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its third reading and adoption.
